His exceptional contributions in Bangladesh Liberation War earned him the Vir Chakra for unwavering determination and tactical brilliance in a special mission operation undertaken in Sept 1971. Later in the war, he was wounded on the outskirts of Chittagong, leading to the award of Prakram Padak (Purple Heart).

During his illustrious military career, Brig Gill attained several milestones, including serving as DivO in NDA and Instructor at Defence Services Staff College, Wellington. He commanded his Bn in IPKF (Sri Lanka). On staff, he served as GSO1 (Ops), Col GS and BGS of a Div/Corps/Comd.

In addition to the military achievements, Brig Gill is also known for selfless service and dedication to the welfare of troops. As an elected member of the IESM and Dir Punjab & Chd cum PRO The War Decorated India, he champions the cause of ex-servicemen. He interacts with local Administration on social & print media platforms, addressing issues of governance and social welfare.

On the academic front, Brig Gill has earned his M Phil degree from the Madras University on the subject of Defence & Strategic Studies with specialisation in International Relations. He has also held the position of Campus Head at the ICFAI Business Management Institute.

Beyond his military attainments and post-retirement contributions to civil society, Brig Gill has done a stint as Chief Administrator with Larsen & Toubro (Urban Infrastructure) in UAE, where he was responsible for General Administration, Industrial & Safety Compliances, Quartering and Banquet Facilities.

He is also an avid motorsports enthusiast, having participated in numerous editions of the Himalayan Car Rally.
