AGNIPATH SCHEME: A SELF INFLICTED INJURY. IT IS NOT ONLY UNETHICAL AND IMMORAL; BUT ALSO A SURE RECIPE FOR MILITARY DISASTER IN THE OFFING

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Iai Hind & Namashkar.

1. I, IC-15090 Colonel SS Rajan, a proud Citizen of Bharat; 13 October 1944 born; June 1963 commissioned in the Bombay Sappers of the Corps of Engineers; and a Veteran of the 1971 War in the Eastern Theatre, culminating in the defeat and surrender of Lt Gen AAK Niazi, the C-in-C of the Pakistan Armed Forces in East Pakistan alongwith 93000 troops and the liberation of Bangladesh on 16 Dec 1971; consider it an honour & a privilege to address this letter to you, our Hon'ble PM, whom I hold in high regards & esteem.

3. **BEWARE**, your enemies and enemies of the Country are not abroad; but standing right next to you & around you; **yes**, amongst the coterie of **YES MEN**, you have assiduously built in the past ten years. - 5. - 6. Please bear in mind that "Khuda na kare, ie. God Forbid, in case the Armed Forces suffer a 'reverse', only YOU and YOU ALONE shall be held responsible for the Catastrophe; and in that event, "Na Raam rahega; na Raam Mandir rahega". It will be a colossal catastrophe with unimaginable consequences, not only for you, our Hon'ble Prime Minister; but for the entire Nation. Setting up of a Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC)

- 7. To save the Nation from the Military Disaster in the offing; I, a War Veteran with over 33 years' service in the Indian Army and a concerned Citizen of this Country most earnestly appeal to you, our Hon'ble Prime Minister, to set up a **Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC)**, tasked to study:
 - (a) the circumstances leading to the evolution of the Agnipath Scheme and its implementation;
 - (b) efficacy of the Agnipath Scheme & its ramifications on Defence & National Security;
 - (c) examine various steps recommended in Para 68 of the attached paper on Agnipath Scheme; and finally,
 - (d) recommend comprehensive Terms & Conditions of service of Soldiers, with a view to ensuring that the Army, Navy & Air Force produce well trained Soldiers who are totally Motivated & exude Morale of the highest order, ever ready to take on the enemy at a moment's notice, keeping in mind the cardinal principle that, 'No soldier shall ever be deprived of his Pension'; with the proviso, where all 'Stake Holders' shall have the privilege of deposing before the Committee.
